

UNIVERSITY DRESS CODE (MALE & FEMALE)

The dress code aims to ensure that students dress in a decent manner. It therefore prohibits some form of dresses/dressing, hairdo/hairstyle, beard, moustache, whiskers, etc.

- 1. Tight, shirt and gowns above the knees (except for sporting purposes).
- 2. Transparent and see-through dresses.
- 3. Semi naked Appearance: wearing of ordinary underwear like singlet, sleeveless/spaghetti dresses that exposes major parts of the wearer's body;
- 4. Skirt which due to slitting, reveals sensitive parts of the wearer's body, and stretch, banded and bandaged elastic material for skirt/gowns (iyera materials)
- 5. Shirt and skimpy dresses, e.g body hugs, show-me-your chest, spaghetti wears and dresses exposing sensitive parts of the body, backless, camisole only;
- 6. Wearing of T shirts with obscene inscriptions
- 7. Shirts that reveal the wearer's chest unduly.
- 8. Sagging/ Earth level/ yansy(use belt).
- 9. Dread, Galax, Fadeout and Rough Coil Hair Cut, Bushy hair, unkempt appearance
- 10. Wearing of earrings by male students
- 11. Wearing of multiple bogus earrings by female students
- 12. Leggies/ Geggies/ pencil trousers.
- 13. Tattered jeans and any materials like right trousers, and all other forms of tight fitting clothes.
- 14. Hair plaiting or weaving by male students.
- 15. Wearing of bathroom slippers around University premises.
- 16. No bangles, beads, rings, etc for male students
- 17. Beards is not allowed, must be clean shaved
- 18. Students I.D card must be worn around the neck always.
- 19. Tattoo with provocative writing or picture.
- 20. Non natural colored hair is not allowed.

21. Dress Code Specifically for Law students:

The Faculty enforces a mode of dressing for all Law Students. Accordingly, admission to classes and other formal occasions is based on compliance with the mode of dressing set out below:

Male students

- a) White long sleeved shirts, black trousers and black tie only; and
- b) Suits, especially during L.S.S functions and other formal occasions.
- c) Simple Black shoe

Female students

- a) Simple black gown
- b) Black skirt and white or black shirt/blouse only; or
- c) Suits, especially during L.S.S. functions and other formal occasions.
- d) Simple Black shoe

Our beloved students, you are enjoined to adhere strictly, at all times, the Dress Code put in place by the University Authorities. You will e addressed the way you are dressed. Everybody in Atiba University Oyo deserves to be treated with respect, therefore dress well in conformity with the Dress Code.

Remember that only students who comply with the Dress Code will be allowed entry into: Library, Lecture rooms, Bursary, Registry, Student Affairs, University Health Centre, Examination Halls and Community Services.

List of Prohibited/ Contraband items in Students' Hostel

- 1. Indian hemp cigarette, hard drugs (such as cocaine, heroin, and other illicit drugs).
- 2. Alcoholic drinks lethal weapons/injection.
- 3. Knives, guns and bullets, knockout/ fireworks of any kind
- 4. Kerosene lamp, gas cooker, candles, matches and lighters cooking utensils such as hotplates, rice cookers, toasters, microwaves, electric boiling rings, saucepans.
- 5. Blenders hair dryers/ straighteners refrigerators/ grillers
- 6. Any item meant for sale or business activities
- 7. Raw food items
- 8. Diabolic food items
- 9. Television sets and CDs video machines, tapes, VCD and DVD players TV cards, antennas computer games(play stations)
- 10. Weight/ shot − put
- 11. Condoms and Contraceptives Tramadol, Codeine.

Other contraband items may be specified will be published from time to time.
